FAQ Highlights

This section includes technical assistance questions the MTS Training and TA Center have responded to during the previous month. The Compilation of FAQs includes all questions that have been answered since August 2021.

Q: What updates can the JSI team provide around the FMAP payments? In going through the remittance advice there seems to be money missing for my district

A: Schools were paid 60% of their HCBS payment initially. This was an issue with how the system was setup to pay. The request to have the missing 40% was just processed, and as mentioned, schools should see the remaining money on their 7/14 RA.
