FAQ Highlights

This section includes technical assistance questions the MTS Training and TA Center have responded to during the previous month. The Compilation of FAQs includes all questions that have been answered since August 2021.

Q: For evaluations that are a flat rate, such as procedure code 92522TM, If the provider only spends 45 minutes on the evaluation, is the reimbursed amount going to be the Medicaid flat rate (for 92522TM it is \$98.72) or the lesser of the Medicaid or actual provider costs.

A: In all cases, providers should submit their real costs for billing to Medicaid. The claim will pay at the lesser of the two rates between the flat rate and the actual cost. In this case, it sounds like the actual cost is less than that of the Medicaid flat rate, so the actual cost would be paid out with this claim.

Q: Just a quick question regarding Provisional SLP. Are we allowed to bill for their work? Do they need to be signed by an SLP?

A: Currently in NH Provisional licensure is not eligible for Medicaid Billing. At even the national level provisional licenses are not eligible for billing Medicaid. Linked is a copy of a document from the Healthy Students,
