(e) No license shall be required for any of the following:

(3) An individual who is a licensed agent or broker and who adjusts or assists in the adjustment of losses arising under policies of insurance issued through or serviced by such agent or broker; provided, however, that the Commissioner may promulgate regulations addressing the parameters pursuant to which a licensed agent or broker

SYNOPSIS

This Bill would reinstate language formerly in the Delaware Code which would permit insurance agents to issue checks to policyholders in time sensitive situations without having to qualify as claims adjusters. This practice would be subject to regulation by the Department of Insurance.
