V – VERIFY INTENTS

Gather intents, micro-topics, and persona variations

Activities

- ✓ Interview customers
- Mine niche communities
- Build persona variations
- Market research with AI

Why it Works

Al Mode retrieves relevant passages in vector space that align with search intent, person history, and decision chains.

Customer Research



- Find a niche forum
- Mine Reddit for micro-topics

Prompt

Your task is to extract verbatim quotes that match any of these criteria:

- 1. Emotionally charged statements
- Quotes that express strong feelings or opinions. Look for:
- Positive: "compelling", "amazing", "incredible", "love"
- Negative: "disgusting", "terrible", "sucks", "hate"
- 2. Requests for assistance or advice

Quotes seeking help, guidance, or information. Look for phrases like:

- "Does anyone know..."

E – Expand Relevance

Develop semantically relevant content

Activities

- Publish persona-targeted micro-topics
- Lead with core information backed by specifics
- Use AI for semantic enrichment

Why It Works

Al Mode infers relevance from the semantic proximity of your content to relevant topics and entities.

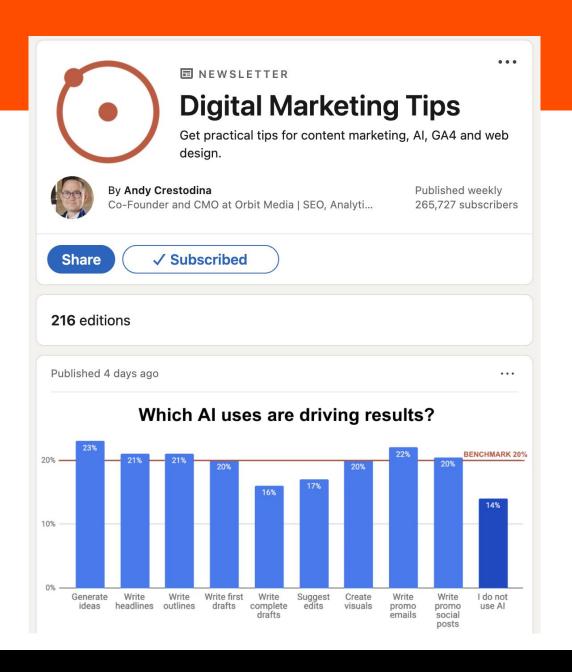
Relevance Optimization

Prompt

Brainstorm 10 phrases related to the search intent provided.

Then, add the phrases to 10 sentences in the article provided.

Search Intent: Find discount ski equipment at the end of the ski season.



Content Optimization

Original Sentence: "This chair is designed to be comfortable for long hours of work."

Suggested Edit: "This is one of the best office chairs for back pain, featuring lumbar support and an adjustable design that promotes proper posture during extended desk work."

C – Clarify Answers

Craft content passages for standalone retrieval

Activities

- ✓ Aim for semantic density
- ✓ Add relevant examples, analogies, entities, and comparisons
- ✓ Write passages that answer one specific question

Why It Works

Al Mode favors concise, self-contained passages that directly answer a specific question

Direct Answers – FAQs

What role does crawlability play in determining crawl budget?

Crawlability has to do with the possibilities Google has to crawl your website. Crawlers can be blocked from your site. There are a few ways to block a crawler from your website. If your website or a page on your website is blocked, you're saying to Google's crawler: "do not come here". Your site or the respective page won't turn up in the search results in most of these cases.

Explicit Lists – Pros and Cons

Pros	Cons
Access to higher-paying job opportunities	High cost of tuition and potential student debt
Structured learning and access to expert professors	Time commitment—typically 4+ years
Networking opportunities with peers, professors, and alumni	Uncertain return on investment for some fields
Personal growth and exposure to diverse ideas	Opportunity cost: income lost while attending college
Often required for certain professions (doctor, lawyer, engineer)	Alternatives like trade schools, apprenticeships, or entrepreneurship may suit some better

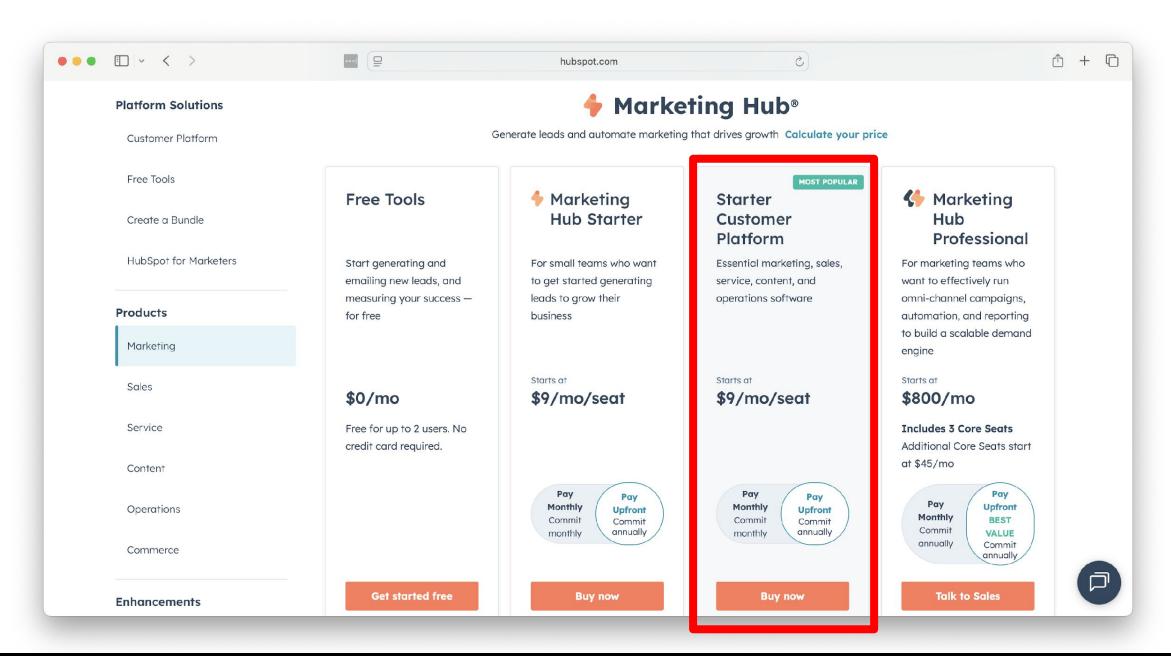

How Much Does Suboxone Cost?
