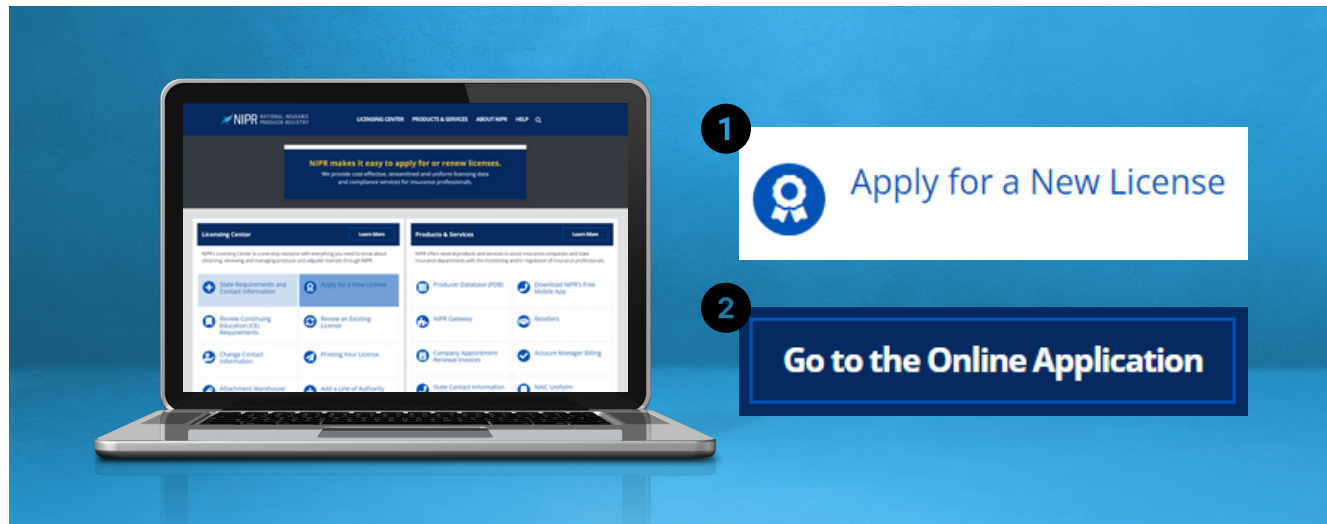
## What's Ahead?

# Implementation Details: Resellers & Industry Customers

Now processing Resident and Nonresident Licensing and Renewals for all major lines and core limited lines license offerings for individual applicants in New York.

## Exams

- NIPR will load and validate exams on behalf of NY.
- Exams are loaded once per day and valid for 2 years from the date they are taken.

## Renewal Information

- Renewal period is 180 days prior to license expiration.
- All active lines of authority (LOA) must be renewed.
- Renewals cannot be submitted after the expiration date. Once expired, and showing as 'Inactive' on PDB, applicants must "relicense" and submit through the initial licensing process.
- A reciprocal license is required for Excess Lines (Surplus Lines). Applicants without a reciprocal license will not be able to apply.
- P.O. Boxes and Private Mailboxes are not allowed for Residence and Business Addresses; a physical address is required.
